LGBTQ Disney employ's are gathered in various locations across the U.S. to protest CEO Bob Chapek's actions towards Florida's legislation that they say has dubbed the "Don't Say Gay" bill.

For those not aware, Florida's senate has passed the 'Don't Say Gay' bill which many U.S citizens especially those in Florida which has over 400,000 Gay residents has protested. LGBTQ workers and supporters are expected to take place in a walkout at office locations in California, Florida and many other locations in protest of Chapek's response to the "Don't Say Gay" bill.

In the past few weeks, Bob Chapek has been under intense criticism and has been trying to clean up his reputation. The citizens of Florida feel that Chapek didn't take a big enough stand against HB 1557 (the "Don't Say Gay bill). HB 1557 is a bill that prohibit's instruction about sexual orientation in kindergarten through the third grade.

After HB 1557 was passed, it left not only the state, but the nation in shock, however, it appears that Chapek has been trying to get on the good side of the people even stating in a letter

"It is clear that this is not just an issue about a bill in Florida, but instead yet another challenge to basic human rights. You needed me to be a stronger ally in the fight for equal rights and I let you down, I am sorry." Chapek said in the letter

He also announced that the company would put all donations to elected officials in Florida on hold until the situation was resolved. This statement and Chapel's letter unfortunately did not end the outcry, and LGBTQ employees have started making plans for a series of protests during breaks, planning for a walkout on March 29. Disney's employees stated "We have been forced into an impossible and unsustainable position. We must now take action to convince TWDC to protect employees and their families. However other's are protecting Chapek and saying that passing that bill was his decision and other's should respect that. People have begun calling the employee's baby's who want everything their way. There are two sides to this argument, but one of the biggest one's that many people have is supporting the Protester's saying that the "Don't Say Gay" bill goes against all that American's stand for, and that they're destroying the basic idea that "love is love."
